

## **[Centre Specific Information]**

Perhaps your centre is remote. Or an integrated boarding house is the main option for accommodation. Your centre might be near a beach or in a very cold or very hot and humid climate. Students might need special clothing, Or to make special travel arrangements to get to your Centre. These are all issues that you will need to consider thoroughly to comply with Area F in the NEAS Quality Assurance Framework.

Many Centres that enrol under 18 students can be a little different from typical central city based Centres. Explore what makes your Centre different or unique, both in terms of attracting students and in terms of potential vulnerabilities for young learners. Consider holding focus groups with teachers, administration staff and students to list all of the unique attributes of your Centre that prospective and newly enrolling students - and their parents and agents - need to be made aware of.
