


A Stateless Beginning

- Born in Afghanistan during civil war
- Grew up in Pakistan, lived without nationality
- Felt invisible and disconnected from community







Surviving, Not Living

- Lived in constant survival mode
- Enrolled in school under fake names
- Parents believed education was our only way out
- Father Passed away, I had to take the lead and responsibilities
- Worked as rug maker









Survival Mode

- Living day-by-day
- No room for dreams—just survival
- Realization: something had to change



Seeking Asylum

Left everything behind

Journey full of fear, uncertainty & risk

Sought identity and belonging









This Risky & Dangerous Journey





- Crossing borders, escaping police
- Nearly drowned in a river
- Prayed in the storm while stranded at sea
- Escaped across borders, faced near-death moments
- Arrival at Christmas Island marked a new beginning
- Failed multiple attempts
- Boarded a boat to Australia 70+ hours at sea






Arrival in Australia


